

EAST VILLAGE ACCESS

East Village Access (EVA) is a **PROS or Personalized Recovery Oriented Services** program. EVA is a recovery program for adults with psychiatric disabilities, designed to provide a comprehensive array of services and treatment to facilitate recovery, wellness, and support, while you attain your own personal goals.

To be admitted into our program, you must:

- Be 18 years of age or older;
- Have a mental health diagnosis and related disability that severely limits your opportunity to pursue meaningful goals

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

What can the program do for me?

Our program supports goals to improve skills in all areas: socializing, employment, living situations, and educational environments of all kinds. We help you address personal barriers that hold you back from realizing your goals. We offer four different kinds of services – general services designed to help you live successfully in the community; more specialized services, depending on your particular need, such as relapse prevention; services designed to assist you in keeping your job; and clinic treatment with a psychiatrist and nurse.

What will my day at East Village Access look like?

Once you've designed your program and chosen your classes, you will probably be here several days per week, and attend two to three classes/groups per day. We're open from Monday through Friday 9AM-5PM. In addition to classes, we serve a light breakfast and lunch, and offer a variety of activities, including yoga, writing workshops, art and computer classes. We also have featured monthly events like community meetings and family and friends night. East Village Access is a place where you can have fun, and learn and grow at the same time.

How long will I be in this program?

Our services are very individualized, and we want to help you build a life around skills and strengths that you already have. Once you are in the program, we will evaluate your progress together, to see where you have made strides. Steps toward reaching your goals are planned to make the most of your time here.

How can I pay for services at East Village Access?

Our services are covered by Medicaid. If you do not have Medicaid, but think you are eligible, we can help you get it. For those who are not eligible for Medicaid, we have a sliding scale, based on your ability to pay.

How can I start the admission process?
